Note: (a) Including stars indicating a military rank
(b) Except sparks (1.15.7), star-shaped throwing weapons such as ninja stars (23.1.25), Stars of David (24.11.15) and starlets (24.17.3)

1.3 Sun

Note: Except for representations of the sun which are only visible from a disc without rays and are classified in the appropriate subsections of section 26.1

1.5 Earth, globes, planets

1.7 Moon

Note: Including representations of the moon with star(s)

1.11 Constellations, asterisms, starry skies, celestial globes, celestial maps

1.13 Armillary spheres, planetaria, orbits of celestial bodies, atomic models, molecular models

1.15 Natural phenomena

Note: Except for arrangements of lines that do not use sound or electromagnetic waves represent (A 26.11.22)

1.17 Geographic maps, planispheres

Note: Not included World maps in two hemispheres (1.5.1 and A 1.5.4)

Category 2: Humans Beings

Note: (a) Inscriptions representing a human being are classified in 27.3.1

(b) Heads are listed in the appropriate subsections of sections 2.1, 2.3, 2.5 or 2.7 and not in 2.9.25

2.1 Men

Note: Not including young people classified in 2.1, 2.3 or 2.7

2.7 Mixed groups, scenes

Note: (a) A mixed group is a group of men, women and/or children. A group of men, women or children is included in the appropriate Classify subsections 2.1, 2.3 or 2.5

(b) However, any group, regardless of its composition, is a scene, into the appropriate subsections of section 2.7

2.9 Parts of the human body, skeletons, skulls

Category 3: Animals

Note: (a) Heads of quadrupeds or quadrupeds are classified in the appropriate subsections of sections 3.1 to 3.5 and not classified in 3.6.25

(b) A script or typographical sign representing an animal is listed in 27.3.3

3.1 Quadrupeds (Series I): Lions, tigers or other large cats, domestic cats or other small cats, dogs, wolves, foxes, bears, koalas, wombats, pandas

3.2 Quadrupeds (Series II): Elephants, mammoths, hippos, rhinoceroses, giraffes, okapis, camels, dromedaries, llamas, alpacas, vicuñas

3.3 Quadrupeds (series III): horses, mules, donkeys, zebras

3.4 Quadrupeds (series IV): cattle, roe deer, stags, elk, reindeer, fawns, antelopes, goats, sheep, mouflons (wild sheep), chamois, pigs, boars, warhogs

3.5 Quadrupeds (series V): Quadrupeds: rabbits, hares, squirrels, beavers, marmots, badgers, martens, minks, wolverines, raccoons, skunks, armadillos, platypuses, rats, mice, moles, hamsters, hedgehogs, porcupines, pangolins, anteaters, kangaroos

Note: Not including domestic appliances, spinning wheels (15.3) or office machines (15.5)

Note: Excluding fax machines, printers, scanners, photocopiers (A 16.1.12)

15.7 Wheels, bearings

15.9 Electrical material

Note: Except electric lamps and radio tubes (13.1.6) or electric cable (14.1.5)

Category 16: Telecommunications, sound recording or reproduction, computers, photography, cinematography, optics

Category 17: Watches, jewellery, measures and weights

Note: Includes all representations of products not included in other categories, sections or subsections, such as coal, coke, briquettes, ingots, etc.

Category 25: Ornamental motifs, surfaces or backgrounds with ornaments

25.1 Ornamental motifs

Note: Except for ornamental motifs from plants classified in section 5.13 or horizontally extended ornamental surfaces as described in section 25.3

25.3 Horizontally extended ornamental surfaces

Note: Except for elongated elliptical surfaces, which are classified in section 26.1 are elongated triangular surfaces classified in section 26.3, or extended four-sided surfaces, which are classified in section 26.4

25.5 Two or four-part backgrounds

Note: Including by lines or bands or by areas of different structures two or four-part backgrounds

25.7 Surfaces or backgrounds with repetitive image elements or inscriptions

25.12 Surfaces or backgrounds with other ornamentation

Category 26: Geometrical figures and solids

Note: (a) Including geometric figures and bodies consisting of humans, animals, Plants or objects
(b) Except for inscriptions forming geometrical figures, which are listed in section 27.1 in section 27.1

26.1 Circles, ellipses

26.2 Segments or sectors of circles or ellipses

26.3 Triangles, lines forming an angle

Category 27: Forms of writing, numerals

27.1 Letters or numbers representing geometric figures, lettering shown in perspective

Note: Includes both a single letter or digit and a group of letters or numbers

27.3 letters or numbers, a human being, an animal, a plant, a celestial body, a representing a natural phenomenon or an object

Note: (a) Including punctuation marks representing a human being, animal, plant represent a celestial body, a natural phenomenon or an object

(b) Includes a letter, number or punctuation mark as well as group of letters, a group of numbers or a group of punctuation marks that represent a human being, an animal, a plant, a celestial body, a represent a natural phenomenon or object

27.5 Letters in special script

Note: Includes both one and more letters and a series of letters that forms a word

27.7 Numbers in special font

Category 28: Inscriptions in various characters

Note: Of course, the sections on inscriptions in characters that are in are commonly used in a particular country, but not in that country be taken into account. In those cases, the inscriptions constitute word marks
